

PopIT Gallery Images - Parameter Table

Parameters for **PopIT Refs** when creating a **PopIT Image LinX** to images in **FS galleries**.

The only required parameters are: '**G**' + **image ID**

Click on the *[Edit]* button in the '*Photos in this gallery*' option in your Gallery Manager to find the image ID's.

All PopIT LinX **MUST START** with **[[** and **END** with **]]**

All parameters **MUST** be separated by a colon ':'

eg: **[[G354:txt=see my gallery photo:title=view my gallery photo]]**

P	Description	Example Usage
G	The first character must be G followed by the image ID	#354
txt	The text you want to use for the image link (default is the image thumbnail) Use this if you don't want the thumbnail to display.	txt=see my gallery photo
title	The mouseover text (default is the image title & description) Enter the text you want to display when the mouse is held over the link.	title=view my gallery photo
width	The width of the thumbnail (default is the actual thumbnail width) Use this if you want to reduce the thumbnail width. Note: the height will be adjusted in proportion.	width=150
height	The height of the thumbnail (default is the actual thumbnail height) Use this if you want to reduce the thumbnail height. Note: the width will be adjusted in proportion.	height=200
link	The type of link - text or button (default is the image thumbnail) Use this if you want to display the link as a button instead of the thumbnail or plain text.	link=button
button	The background colour of the button (default is orange) Only use this if you have also set link=button and you want a different colour button background.	button=yellow
align	Alignment of thumbnail (default is no alignment) Use this if you want your thumbnail to align left or right in relation to any text around it. Note: you can insert your LinX in table cells for more precise alignment.	align=left
imgborder	The thumbnail border colour (default is no border) Only use this if you want a border around your thumbnail image.	imgborder=black
margin	The thumbnail margin space (default is 15 pixel) Only use this if you want a larger margin around your thumbnail image.	margin=30
